Woodie's Wash Shack has been authorized to reopen and provide its unique disinfecting services after seeking legal relief from a prior order of closure.

Woodie's Wash Shack is a state-of-the-art facility at 5601 66<sup>th</sup> Street North in St. Petersburg where both the exterior and interior of a vehicle may be disinfected effectively, safely, and in accordance with CDC guidelines.

These disinfecting services are now available to all essential workers under Governor Ron DeSantis's executive orders regarding Covid-19, such as medical personnel, law-enforcement officers, taxis, ride-sharing drivers, and food-delivery services.

All customers, regardless of their membership status at Woodie's, will need to declare themselves essential before disinfection may occur. Each vehicle will then proceed through a wash tunnel where disinfectant is applied to its exterior. The vehicle will thereafter advance to a separate station for disinfection of its interior.

Burton, as the County Administrator for Pinellas County, and Bob Gualtieri, as the Sheriff of Pinellas County. The action was assigned to circuit court judge, Thomas H. Minkoff.
